
Dear Jeremy

We have now completed preliminary pen trials of Plantskydd against both possums and wild rabbits. I enclose copies of data which show the % of individual trees remaining over time, using Treepel as a positive control treatment.

I have also enclosed a copy of a paper which explains the method we use for pen assessments of repellents, and attached is a summary of the analysis of Plantskydd v. Treepel showing a comparison of the mean area under the browse curves. This shows that Plantskydd was significantly more effective than Treepel against rabbits, and equally effective as Treepel against possums.

If you would like us to continue with a more robust phase of assessment, involving field trials, we would be happy to discuss the options by which this research could be done.
